Enclosed is a <u>letter</u>¹ I sent to the Honorable James D. Whittemore on July 14, 2011, raising issues regarding the administration of the trial of *United States v. Kevin L. White*, 8:11-cr-00318-JDW-TGW-1, which is to be personally tried by United States Attorney Robert E. O'Neill, in light of matters calling into question the trustworthiness of Mr. O'Neill and the publicizing of those matters. The letter is also the subject of a July 18, 2011 item on the site of the organization Truth in Justice ("<u>United States Attorney Robert E. O'Neill and the Impending Prosecution of Kevin L. White</u>").

As discussed in the Truth in Justice item, subsequent to posting the letter to Judge Whittemore, I came to understand that since Mr. O'Neill's appointment as United States Attorney he has personally tried at least one other case (*United States v. Jemenez*, 8:11-cr-00197-SCB-TGW). I
